

# “Red Flag” Violations

These driver violations are always investigated as part of a carrier investigation

BASIC	Part	Violation Description
Driver Fitness	383.21	Operating a CMV with more than one driver's license
Driver Fitness	383.23(a)(2)	Operating a CMV without a valid CDL
Driver Fitness	383.51(a)	Driving a CMV (CDL) while disqualified
Driver Fitness	383.91(a)	Operating a CMV with improper CDL group
Driver Fitness	391.11	Unqualified driver
Driver Fitness	391.11(b)(5)	Driver lacking valid license for type vehicle being operated
Driver Fitness	391.11(b)(7)	Driver disqualified from operating CMV
Driver Fitness	391.15(a)	Driving a CMV while disqualified
Controlled Substances/Alcohol	392.4(a)	Driver uses or is in possession of drugs
Controlled Substances/Alcohol	392.5(a)	Possession/use/under influence alcohol-4hrs prior to duty
Fatigued Driving (HOS)	395.13(d)	Driving after being declared out-of-service
Vehicle Maintenance	396.9(c)(2)	Operating an Out-Of-Service (OOS) vehicle
